

Appendix K – Licensing Applications

Notification of licensing (alcohol) applications that are open for consultation are received weekly by the Clerk. These notifications cover all of Dorset and a lot of the time will be of no consequence to Toller Porcorum. While an application for Toller Porcorum itself is unlikely, applications close by - Maiden Newton, for example - particularly if they could increase traffic to, or close to, the Parish, may be of interest.

Parish Councils can submit representations on applications which can be supportive or raising concerns/objections. Submissions must be linked to one or more of the four licensing objectives (which are different to the considerations under planning law);

- The prevention of crime and disorder
- The prevention of public nuisance
- Public safety
- The protection of children from harm

Before making any representation the following should be considered: [Revised Guidance issued under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003](https://publishing.service.gov.uk) (publishing.service.gov.uk), particularly paragraphs 8.13-8.14 as well as Chapter 9.

It is up to Toller Porcorum Parish Council how these applications are considered and dealt with. Below are some suggestions:

- Consider only applications for premises within the Parish boundary
- Consider applications for premises within an 'x' mile radius of the Parish ('x' to be determined)
- Consider applications for premises on a list of places of interest (list of places of interest to be determined)
- Consider none of the applications
